



## **Tournament Safety: What to Expect**

We look forward to hosting golfers, volunteers, and staff at the **Tennessee Kidney Foundation (TKF) Golf Invitational** on Monday, June 29, 2020 at the prestigious The Governors Club golf course in Brentwood, Tennessee and want to share some of the measures that will be in place during the course of the tournament to ensure the safety and comfort of all attendees. More details will be provided in the days before the tournament.

### **Updated Format:**

Instead of our traditional two-shotgun format, all teams will be assigned tee times staggered throughout the day between 7am and 3:30pm to ensure that we minimize the number of people arriving to check in at any given time. Tee time slots are offered on a first come, first served basis. If you have not registered yet, please sign up as soon as possible to reserve your tee time. [Click here to register](#). An electronic scoring app will be used this year as in the past several previous years, so scores will be submitted through the app. Course volunteers will be available to assist as needed.

### **Registration:**

Golfers will check in during their allotted time slots outside the clubhouse with our staff and/or volunteers. All volunteers and tournament staff will wear masks, and complimentary masks will be provided for all golfers to wear at their discretion. Social distancing will be in place at registration, with markers in place to designate waiting areas at least 6 feet apart, and golfers will handle their own clubs.

### **Golf Carts:**

All golf carts will be sanitized prior to use, hand sanitizer and/or disinfectant wipes will be provided on each cart, and each golfer will receive a new disposable steering wheel cover in their gift bag upon arrival.

### **Golfer Shirts and Gift Bags:**

Golfer gifts and shirts will be provided each golfers' arrival in pre-packaged bags. If you are fielding a team and have not submitted shirt sizes for your team, please do so as soon as possible.

### **Driving Range**

The range will be open on the day of the tournament with measures in place to encourage social distancing. More details to be provided soon.

### **Meals and Beverages:**

Boxed meals will be provided for all golfers throughout the day. Beverage carts will be available, with all club staff outfitted in personal protective gear. Individual snacks will be provided in golfer carts upon arrival.

### **Auction:**

The auction will take place entirely online. A link will be provided to you soon with the available auction items and instructions for bidding.



**Prizes and Awards:**

Prizes and awards distribution and sponsor recognition will be provided in a modified format in lieu of the traditional clubhouse reception. The event will take place virtually on Facebook Live and Zoom, and a decision will be made in the days prior to the tournament about the availability of an on-site, outdoor presentation.

**Volunteers:**

Volunteers are critical to the success of this event, and we are committed to their safety. Social distancing will be maintained between all volunteers throughout the day, complimentary masks and gloves will be provided, and hand sanitizer and disinfectant wipes will be widely available.
