On behalf of TKF's Board of Directors and Staff, we thank you for your support of the Tennessee Kidney Foundation throughout the 2024-2025 fiscal year. By supporting TKF, you provide a lifeline for our program clients who need range from accessing critical, life-sustaining assistance to people who face food insecurity, to community members at risk for kidney disease who just need 15 minutes at one of our free health screenings to identify risk factors and get the help they need to prevent kidney failure.

Take it from Marlon, a former program participant of TKF whose enrollment in our transportation assistance program led to his excellent attendance rate for dialysis, and his eventual listing for transplant. Because of supporters like you, this year TKF:

- Expanded programs from 42 counties to 53 counties in Middle and West Tennessee
- Underwrote more than 45,000 trips through our transportation assistance program, ensuring clients have access to care for life-sustaining dialysis treatments and transplant follow-up appointments.
- Hosted 12 preventive health screenings for hundreds of Middle Tennesseans, offering free blood pressure checks, urinalysis testing, and expert consultation for better health management.
- Delivered over 9,000 meals to food-insecure clients across 53 counties, ensuring kidney patients have the nutrition they need to avoid going hungry while also maintaining a kidney-friendly diet.

MISSION


VISION

Its vision is a Tennessee where the rate of kidney disease is minimized and everyone who needs care receives care.

DID YOU KNOW?

1 in 7 adults in the United States—about 49 million people—have chronic kidney disease (CKD), but as many as 9 out of 10 don't even know they have it. It is nicknamed “the silent killer”.



CKD and kidney failure cost Medicare over \$130 billion per year, more than cancer or stroke.



Approximately 20% of people with high blood pressure have chronic kidney disease.



PROGRAMS

Access to Care

TKF underwrites round-trip transportation to life-sustaining care for dialysis patients, transplant candidates, and transplant recipients helping them achieve better health outcomes.

Lobby Days

TKF visits partner dialysis clinics to offer support and encouragement to patients. We provide patient care bags filled with thoughtful items, along with educational materials to help patients stay informed about their kidney health and resources.

Kidney Health Screenings

TKF's Kidney Health Screening & Education Program brings free health screenings and educational resources directly to communities where access to care and information is most limited. Through these community events, participants receive blood pressure, A1C, and urinalysis screenings, along with one-on-one education about kidney health and prevention and a results evaluation with a medical professional.

TKF partners with local corporations, faith centers, universities, and health fairs to offer free kidney education and screenings.

Meal Delivery Program



TKF's free meal delivery program provides food insecure clients with their choice of 7 freshly-prepared, kidney-friendly meals per week delivered to their homes.

WHO WE SERVE


